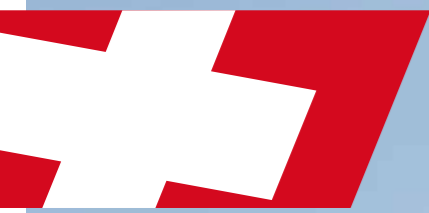

Window to the Swiss Alps

From Zermatt and the Matterhorn, the panoramic trip leads over 291 bridges and through 91 tunnels over the Swiss Alps to St. Moritz. The Glacier Express winds its way through remote valleys, past sheer rock faces, idyllic mountain villages, over the Landwasser Viaduct and through the Rhine Gorge, the Grand Canyon of Switzerland. It scales the highest point of its journey at the Oberalp Pass with ease at 2033 metres above sea level.

Thanks to the large panoramic windows, a clear view of numerous summits, deep gorges and the UNESCO World Heritage sites "Swiss Alps Jungfrau-Aletsch" and "Rhaetian Railway in the Albula/Bernina Landscapes" is guaranteed. The menus are prepared freshly in the on-board kitchen and served to you at your seat.

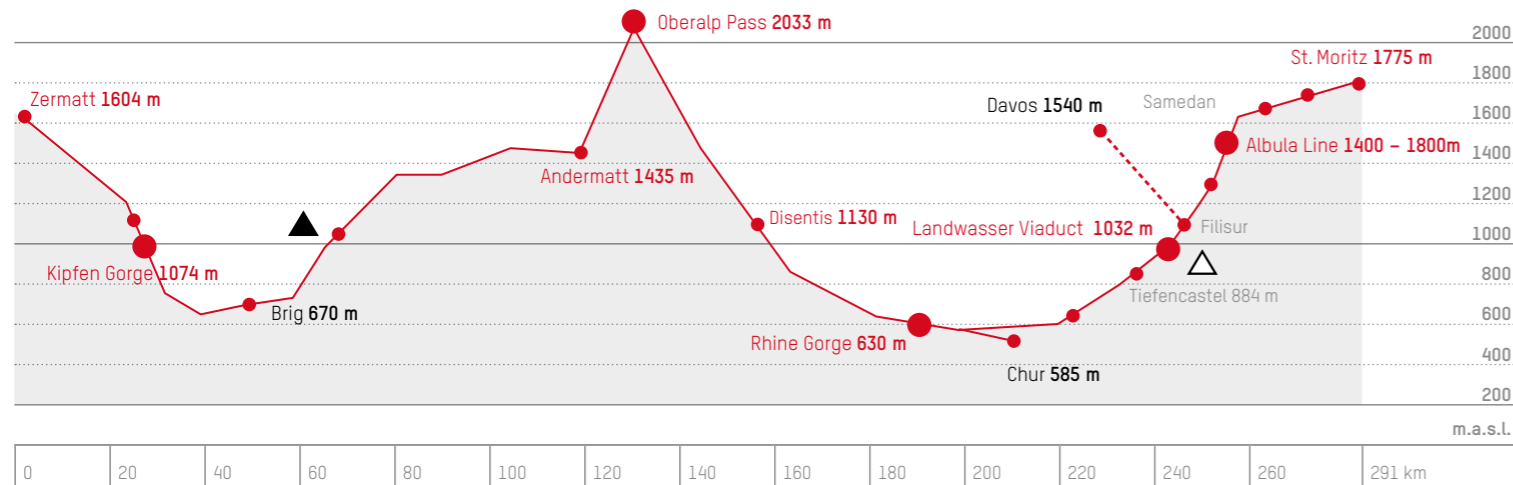

HIGHLIGHTS ALONG THE ROUTE



UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE: ▲ "Swiss Alps Jungfrau-Aletsch" △ Rätische Bahn "Albula/Bernina"

En route from Zermatt to St. Moritz the Glacier Express comprises the following highlights and excursion attractions:

Matter Valley

The Matter Valley between Zermatt and Stalden spans some 25 kilometres and offers a remarkable range of scenic splendours – eternal ice, deep ravines and rugged rockfaces; 29 four-thousand-metre peaks and flowering Alpine meadows; the highest-altitude vineyards in Europe and superb ski runs. Running through the valley is the wild and foaming River Matter Vispa, which converges with the Saaser Vispa at Stalden before joining the Rhone at Visp.



Kipfen Gorge

Close to Kalpetran, the Glacier Express continues through the wild and romantic Kipfen Gorge along one of the route's most scenic sections. The train line and the River Vispa run parallel at close quarters, and in the past flooding and avalanches have caused considerable damage. The flow of the Vispa is now regulated and the railway track protected by masonry to avoid further damage.



Andermatt

Andermatt is located at the foot of the 2,033-metre Oberalp Pass in the canton of Uri, along the 144-kilometre network of the Matterhorn Gotthard Bahn. From here trains depart for Disentis, Göschenen and Zermatt. Due to the already partly opened new tourism resort Andermatt Swiss Alps, Andermatt is developing into an attractive year-round vacation destination.



Oberalp Pass

The Oberalp Pass links Disentis/Mustér in Canton Graubünden with Andermatt in Canton Uri. At 2,033 metres, it is the highest point on the route of the Glacier Express. Located even higher to the south is Lake Toma (2,345 metres), recognized as the source of the River Rhine.



Disentis Monastery

Disentis is dominated by the oldest Benedictine monastery in Switzerland, built in the late 17th century. In 1799 the monastery church was burned and plundered by Napoleon's army. Extensive restoration work was undertaken in the late 19th century. Today it houses a school.



Rhine Gorge – the "Swiss Grand Canyon".

It began 10,000 years ago as the famous Flims landslide – now it is a unique natural backdrop. Over many centuries the River Rhine has carved a path through the bedrock. The result is a ravine renowned as the Swiss Grand Canyon, and one of Switzerland's most impressive natural spectacles. The Rhine Gorge is a popular attraction for hikers, bikers and river-rafters – and can even be toured by train.



Landwasser Viaduct

The Landwasser Viaduct is the most spectacular construction on the 63-kilometre Albula stretch between Thusis and St. Moritz – and the most photographed feature of the entire Rhaetian Railway. It comes into view on the right shortly before the village of Filisur, is 142 metres long and rises impressively to a height of 65 metres. The natural stone viaduct extends in a curve over the rugged Landwasser Valley directly into a tunnel entrance on a vertical rock wall.



Albula Line

The most spectacular section of the Glacier Express Line lies between Preda and Bergün. Six towering viaducts, three spiral tunnels, and two helical tunnels make it possible to scale the 400 metre height difference. A triumph of railway engineering: the railway line between St. Moritz and Thusis belongs to the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Rhaetian Railway in the Albula/Bernina Landscapes".

Gornergrat Railway

Best view of the Matterhorn

If you want to discover the dazzling beauty of the Swiss Alps, you'll soon realise that the trip to the Gornergrat is an essential excursion. Its sunny viewing platform over 3000 m a.s.l., accessible all year, makes the Gornergrat ridge a top destination, and not just because of its altitude. Surrounded by the majestic Matterhorn and 28 other peaks above 4,000 meters, as well as the Gorner Glacier, the Gornergrat offers an awe-inspiring experience that one is unlikely to forget quickly. The highest open-air rack railway in Europe has its starting point in the well-known Valais resort of Zermatt, from where it travels daily during the high season every 24 minutes on the 9,339-metre route to the Gornergrat.

Dining on the move & Railbar

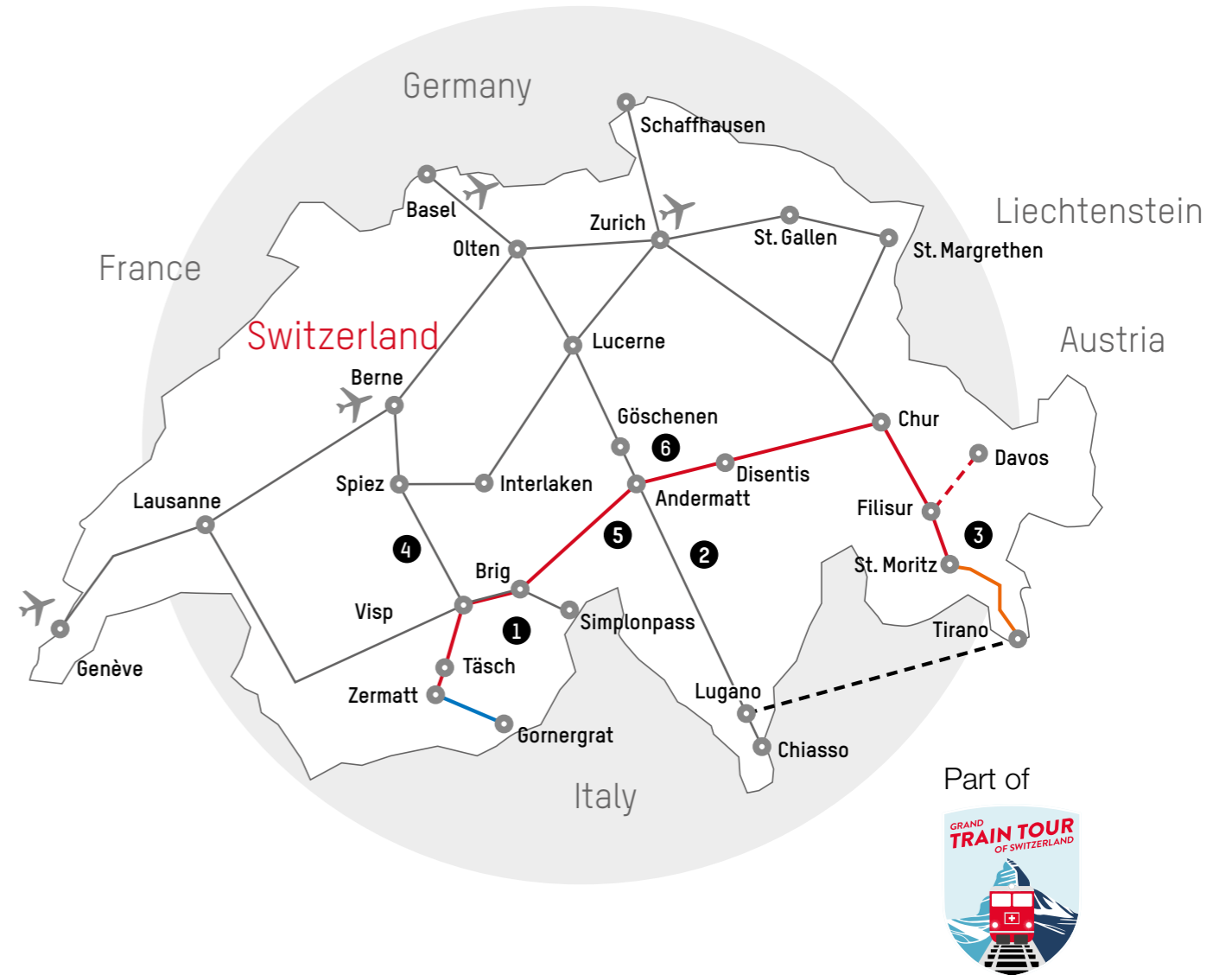

- Since 15.12.2019, new groupe tariffs apply on the Swiss railway network:
- Above 10 persons 30 % discount on the tariff for single traveler ticket
 - Children up to the age of six free of charge (not including Excellence Class: children between the age of 0-6 also require a seat reservation in Excellence Class)
 - From 6 to 16 years: 50 % discount
 - 50% discount with Half Fare Card / Swiss Half Fare Card
 - The surcharges are to be paid in full by all passengers. This also applies to holders of a Swiss Travel Pass, Eurail or Interrail ticket
 - The listed seat reservation surcharges are always to be added to the corresponding fare

Obtaining tickets

on every trip, you will receive an e-ticket once your final communication has been received. The group ticket is issued based on the number of participants registered most recently at Railservice. Please ensure you observe the conditions of cancellation. There can therefore be no subsequent changes or refunds (please also refer to the "General terms and conditions of carriage" page 11).

Payment of tickets

You can purchase all tickets and additional services against invoice or via credit card. Please note that it is not possible to pay by cheque. The purchase of commissioned group tickets for cash at the counter is no longer possible.

Payment modalities within Switzerland

The fee for the ticket should be paid (bank transfer) using the payment order attached.

- Up to 60 days before travel date: 50% of surcharge

Rules reservations through B2B channels

- Reservations for groups (more than 9 PAX) must be made via the Railservice RhB in Chur and may not be made via the B2B shop.
- Groups may not be split in order to meet the conditions.
- Should Glacier Express AG identify unauthorized or abusive group bookings via the webshop, it explicitly reserves the right to withdraw from the contract, cancel these bookings without replacement, and automatically issue a refund.

Bookings for groups (10 or more people)

Group reservations can be submitted at any time. Early reservation is recommended. Groups are seated together in the same carriage whenever possible. Final confirmation details (number of train, carriage and seat) will be sent to you 27 days prior departure. The maximum group size in 1st class is 36 people and in 2nd class is 70 people in summer and 48 people in winter.

There are also two channels providing musical entertainment throughout your journey. All travellers receive the exclusiv board magazine with featuring further information about the Glacier Express.

In eight hours, you will travel from the Matterhorn across the Swiss Alps to St. Moritz on the Glacier Express. Thanks to panoramic windows up to the ceiling, you have unobstructed views of snow-capped mountain peaks and breathtaking scenery. The Glacier Express is committed to the pioneering days of the railway, when travelling was still about unforgettable journeys.

Andermatt station

The parking lot for bus arrivals is located on the north side of the Andermatt station (approach via the Radisson Hotel exit). There are no bus parking spaces available on the south side. The maximum parking time is 30 minutes. A map can be requested via info@glacierexpress.ch

For safety reasons, the maximum height of buses is now 3.50 m.
